Day 1: Board your flight to London.

Day 2: London

- Meet with your tour director at London Heathrow Airport.
- Board your private motor coach and enjoy a guided panoramic city tour. Get a glimpse of London landmarks like Buckingham Palace, the Houses of Parliament, the Big Ben clock tower, and Trafalgar Square.
- Take a ride on the London Eye, the world's tallest cantilevered observation wheel, rotating 450 feet above the River Thames.

Day 3: London

- Visit **Westminster Abbey**, a major institution of British history and burial place of Isaac Newton, Charles Darwin, and many kings and queens of the Empire.
- Enjoy free time for lunch at Covent Garden.
- No trip to London is complete without visiting Shakespeare's **Globe Theatre.** The historically reconstructed venue will teach your group about the life and works of "The Bard."
- Savor British delicacies during dinner at a traditional English pub.

Day 4: London

- Visit the Tower of London, famous home of the Crown Jewels.
 During its history, the fortress served as a royal palace, a prison, an armory, and even a zoo.
- Spend free time for lunch at the ancient Leadenhall Market.
- Explore the National Gallery and view masterpieces from the Middle Ages to the 19th century, including works by Renoir, van Gogh, Michelangelo, and British artists like William Turner and John Constable.
- Take advantage of a free evening in London.

Day 5: Paris

- Head to London Saint-Pancras Station, where you will board the train to Paris Gare du Nord train station.
- Board your private motor coach for a 3-hour sightseeing tour of the city of lights with a local guide. Famous sites include Pont Neuf, the Champs-Élysées and the Arc de Triomphe.
- Visit the iconic **Eiffel Tower**, where you might get to see Paris from a new point of view.

Day 6: Paris

- Discover the treasures of the Louvre. Formerly a royal palace, it houses masterpieces like the Venus de Milo and the Mona Lisa.
 Mixing classic and modern, a Nintendo 3DS guides you through the many collections.
- Enjoy free time for lunch while you explore the Latin Quarter.
- Travel back to ancient times at the ruins of a Gallo-Roman Arena. Live like a local playing pétanque, a traditional bowling game, and practicing French!
- Unwind on a stroll in the charming Montmartre district, overlooking Paris from its highest hill. Admire the architecture of the Basilique du Sacré-Coeur and enjoy the vibrant atmosphere of Place Pigalle and the Moulin Rouge.

Day 7: Paris & Versailles

- Board the train and travel to your guided tour of the Palace of Versailles, including the King's Apartments, the Hall of Mirrors, and the castle's many gardens. While touring the grounds, visit the Ballroom, the Colonnade, and the Enceladus fountain.
- After lunch, return to Paris by train. Take advantage of free time to explore Le Marais, one of the oldest districts in Paris, or take in some shopping on the Grands Boulevards.

Day 8: Rome

- Board your private motor coach and depart to Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport, where you will take a flight to Leonardo da Vinci-Fiumicino Airport in Rome.
- Embark upon a walking tour of Rome's city center. Climb the Spanish Steps at Piazza di Spagna. Shop along Via Condotti and head to the Trevi Fountain, believed to hold mystical powers. Your tour ends at Piazza Navona near the Pantheon. Admire the Fountain of Four Rivers, one of Bernini's Baroque masterpieces.

Day 9: Rome

- Your first stop is a tour of Vatican City, an independent state in the heart of Rome. Explore St. Peter's Basilica, a late Renaissance church that can hold nearly 60,000 people. The highlight of your tour will be the Sistine Chapel, with Michelangelo's masterful frescoes on the ceiling. Afterward, be sure to take a stroll through the Vatican gardens.
- Take a guided tour of the Colosseum and the Roman Forum.

Day 10: Depart to the airport for your flight home.
