SAMPLE ITINERARY

DAY 1:

- Visit Mackinaw Crossings and Mackinac City.
- Tour Colonial Michilimackinac, where students can watch reenactments in a reconstructed 1715 fur trading village.
- Take a ferry to Mackinac Island.
- Explore Fort Mackinac, built by the British during the American Revolution. The bluffside fort played an important role during the War of 1812, and students can interact with costumed interpreters during your immersive tour.
- Check into the historic Mission Point Hotel.
- Enjoy a concert by Three Men and a Tenor! The group combines a capella vocal talent with comedic elements.

DAY 2:

- Hone your skills during a Mackinac Music Clinic led by a music professional or university clinician.
- Enjoy a horse-drawn carriage ride through historic Mackinac Island, an authentic Victorian setting where transportation is limited to horse and buggy, bicycle, or your own two feet.
- Explore downtown Mackinac Island, home to one of National Geographic's Top 10 State Parks in America.
